



Gear Guide Part 1 (The basics)

There will be some experienced riders coming on the rally who will have done a lot of riding and they know what works best for them. This guide is to help people with making decisions on what gear to bring and avoid them wasting money on buying the wrong equipment.

Your camping equipment needs to be light, durable and keep you alive in sub zero temperatures. Most people on the rally will probably camp out no more than five nights the rest of the time they will get a bed in a pub or motel because it is just easier to do this.

Tent

Outerlimits 2 man tent which weighs 1.5 kg and is big enough to put your bed in and some gear. Most one man tents are just too small to fit a good size air mattress and some gear.

Dry Bags

These can be found in most camping shops. The key items that need to go in these are your sleeping bag and spare cloths. I would recommend two 13 litre bags Cost: \$24 each
